This level of curriculum transparency is not common practice and provides families with clear insight into what their child is learning and how best to support them at home. At Serlby Park Academy, we are fully committed to reducing barriers to learning. We support families by providing:

- Free uniform to all Year 7 students, with further support available where needed
- Free equipment in lessons to ensure no student is disadvantaged

- Free memorable visits as part of our personal development programme
- Tablet devices available before school, at break, lunchtime and after school
- An academy library open daily from 8.00am for reading and study
